Texoma Christian School Lifestyle Statement-Employees

Texoma Christian School is a religious, non-profit Christian school organization representing Jesus Christ throughout the evangelical Christian community. TCS requires its employees to be born-again Christians, living their lives as Christian role models (Rom. 10:9-10; I Tim. 4:12; Luke 6:40). Employees will conduct themselves in a way that will not raise questions regarding their Christian testimonies. A Christian lifestyle should reflect the biblical perspective of integrity and appropriate personal and family relationships, business conduct and moral behavior. An employee is expected to demonstrate a teachable spirit, an ability to share love for others, a willingness to live contentedly under authority and a commitment to follow the Matthew 18 principle when an issue arises with fellow colleagues, students, parents or administration.

Texoma Christian School expects employees to maintain a lifestyle based on biblical standards of moral conduct. Moral misconduct, which violates the bona fide occupational qualification for employees to be Christian role models, includes, but is not limited to, promiscuity, homosexual behavior or any other violation of the unique roles of male and female. (Romans 1:21-27; I Corinthians 6:9-20). TCS believes that biblical marriage is limited to a covenant relationship between a man and a woman.

TCS employees will maintain a lifestyle based on biblical standards of conduct. Failure to do so may result in a reprimand or, in some cases, dismissal from employment. It is the goal of TCS that each employee will have a lifestyle where " ... He might have the pre-eminence." Colossians 1:18.
