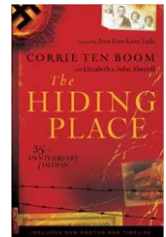
Dear Students,

Your assignments are as follows: Read *The Hiding Place* 35th Anniversary Edition by Corrie Ten Boom with Elizabeth & John Sherrill. You may use an audio book if needed, but you will need a hard copy to follow along with and for reference.
